

# ACTIVITY Surprise Storytelling Box

Use small objects, toys, pictures, and more from your home to inspire telling stories together!

#### MATERIALS

- Shoebox, hat, jar, pot, or basket
- Nature Items: leaves, flowers, sticks
- Household Items: utensils, clothespins, toys
- Art/craft items: yarn, colors, googly eyes
- Magazines (for pictures or photos)
- Scissors

#### ART PROJECT STEPS

- 1. Search outdoors and at home for things you think are interesting.
- 2. Place materials in container.
- 3. Close your eyes and pick something out of the container to start your story.
- 4. Take turns selecting items to build your story as a family.
