THIS SPRING, CMOM IS BURSTING WITH PUPPET-POWERED FUN FOR SPRING RECESS, PASSOVER CELEBRATIONS, AND AN EPIC EGG-STRAVAGANZA!

Spring has sprung at the Children's Museum of Manhattan, and we're inviting families to make the most of the season with hands-on creativity, cultural celebration, and joyful learning!

We kick things off with **Passover programming** from **April 11–13**, featuring artmaking, storytelling, and puppetry that bring the themes of freedom, hope, and resilience to life for young learners. From sewing Afikomen covers to crafting frog puppets and playful Seder plate characters, CMOM offers meaningful and memorable ways to explore tradition through creativity.

Then from **April 14–17**, **Spring Recess transforms into Nature Puppet Fest!** Children can sculpt garden gnome puppets, meet local puppet artists, sing with Chickenshed NYC, and contribute to a collaborative recycled art installation — all while learning about community, climate, and creativity.

And it all builds to our can't-miss, museum-wide Egg-stravaganza weekend April 18–20, complete with eco-friendly basket weaving, wooden egg painting, a puppet-themed scavenger hunt, and sensory play for our youngest visitors.
